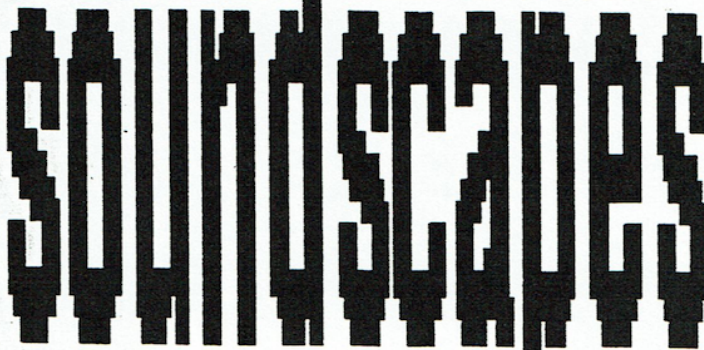

Neil Rolnick is one of America's leading composers of electronic and computer-generated music. His work has been presented at leading art centers and festivals throughout the USA and Europe. He is particularly interested in the electronic processing of acoustic sounds and his program at **PENINE HART GALLERY** will feature several such works. Mr. Rolnick will perform his composition "ReRebonq" with members of **GAMELAN SON OF LION**, New York's New Music Gamelan. The work is based on Balinese gamelan rhythmic patterns, which are transformed during the course of the piece using a portable electronic sound processing system of Mr. Rolnick's design.

Two additional works, featuring artist **SANDY MOORE** and vocalist **KATHLEEN MYERS**, will also be included on the program.
