Inspired by Balinese pieces used in the traditional Cremation ceremony, a joyous occasion releasing the souls of the dead into the spirit world.

Recycling of a familiar tune after it has been digitally remasticated my Max/MSP and throught the jaws of chaos, accompanied by gamelan.

Telling Time

For gamelan and glass A composition in unison tempo is then repeated in "telling time," where each performer tells a story through the use of shifting tempi.

Hemiola Goes East

...is influenced by a piece by Egyptian composer Mohamed Abdel Wahab called "Mudnaka." Hemiola is the rhythmic device juxtaposing two against three.

Music Box

The gamelan becomes the giant music box with suling (flute) duet obbligato.

Wauking

A setting of Scottish work songs learned or heard in Cape Breton, Nova Scotia.

Hard Rain

An arrangement of Mr. Dylan's timeless classic inspired by the Bush administration's tireless efforts on our behalf.
