Gamelan Son of Lion is a new-music repertory ensemble and composers' collective based in downtown New York City, specializing in contemporary pieces written for the instruments of the Javanese gamelan percussion orchestra. It has been performing in the greater NYC area since 1976. The ensemble's instruments were built by Artistic Director Barbara Benary in Indonesian village style, using steel keys, cans, hubcaps, and other materials, along with traditional drums and gongs. All the keyboards are tuned in the traditional slendro and pelog scales.

For today's program the ensemble's composers have also integrated the use of many other instruments, including homemade cardboard-tube xylophones, "styro-cello," computer-processed music box, violin, clarinet, flute, English concertina, shakuhachi and a collection of small toys.
